### Binyang Park

Where: Mallard Drive

Features: Picnic shelter, next to bushland with walkways & bird watching shelter nearby



### Jonas Bradley Oval

Where: Corner of The Ponds Boulevard & Lilypad Avenue

Features: Picnic shelters, BBQs, tennis courts, playground, basketball & netball, exercise stations, toilets open for sporting groups,

Home ground for The Ponds Cricket Club & The Ponds Soccer Club



### Kalina Park

Where: Ridgeline Drive & Ulmara Avenue

Features: Playground



### Lakes Edge Park

Where: Corner of Claret Avenue & Lomandra Crescent (off The Ponds Boulevard)

Features: Picnic shelters, BBQs, toilets, near bushland with walking trails, Lake Ironbark



**Lakes Edge Playground**

Where: Camomile Street (off The Ponds Boulevard)

Features: Picnic shelters, partly fenced playground



**Paperpark Grove**

Where: Arrowroot Street

Features: public art



**Lorius Park**

Where: Viceroy and Mosaic Avenue

Features: Picnic shelters, exercise equipment, playground



**Park at corner of Ridgeline & Riverbank Drive**

Features: Picnic shelters, BBQ, playground



**Owl Park**

Where: Corner of Warbler Street & Stanhope Parkway

Features: Picnic shelters, playgrounds, public art, next to bushland with walking trails



**Peel Reserve**

Where: Corner of Greenview Parade & Alkoomie Street

Features: Oval, amenities block, BBQ & picnic shelters, fenced playground, fitness trail and next to bushland with walkways



**Ridgeline Park**

Where: Ridgeline Drive, between Marsh Way & Kelby Street

Features: Picnic shelters, playground, flying fox



**The Ponds Plaza & Playground**

Where: Pebble Crescent, next to The Ponds Community Hub

Features: Picnic shelters, cycleways, playground, public art, BBQ



**Silver Leaf Park**

Where: Corner of Waterfall Boulevard & Tank Street

Features: Picnic shelters, BBQ, playground



**Waterfall Park**

Where: Corner of Waterfall Boulevard & Shingle Street

Features: Picnic shelter, BBQ, playground, table tennis



**The Gathering Park & Playground**

Where: Meander Crescent

Features: Picnic shelter, playground, public art, next to bushland with walkways
